

The Hong Kong Porcelain Club held its 3rd charity exhibition from Oct 18 - 24, 2007 at the Yue Hwa Chinese Product Emporium Limited in Tsim Sha Tsui.

We were very lucky to have as our guests artists Ms Josephine Robinson from Australia, Mrs Yumiko Okumura from Japan and Mr Filipe Pereira from Portugal. They were at the ribbon-cutting ceremony along with our Club's Chairman Mrs Rosemary Oh, government officials from

Hong Kong and China and a famous movie star from Hong Kong. After the ceremony our guest artists held demonstrations after which the plates were auctioned off to the highest bidders.

In total HK\$70,000 was raised from the auction of the 3 plates. The charity exhibition was very successful we raised about HK\$4 million for Project Vision Charitable Foundation, a charity that was set up with an aim of "teach them to fish" - the doctors go to remote areas of China to set up ophthalmology departments and teach the doctors there to do surgeries for cataract and other eye ailments.

Project Vision is a fairly new charity and with this exhibition we helped create public awareness of this charity through press advertisements and of course, our paintings.
