Currently I am teaching other people (along with my partner, Su Chiu), this wonderful way of art. I enjoy sharing what I've learnt from Rosemary, and accomplishing many pieces of work. The one below is called the Phoenix.

1st FIRING

Using Royal Blue, mix with pen oil to outline the pattern. Put four designs evenly onto the border, and outline them also.

2nd FIRING

Add the Royal Blue colour, making dark and light contrasts.

3rd FIRING

Add more colours to the darker parts, to make more differences between the lighter and darker parts. Dab the border with Royal Blue.

FINAL FIRING

Put the enamel onto the edges.
